An independent, confidential service for birth relatives. This service provides you with access to a qualified counsellor at no cost.

We are not involved with any part of the decision making process and do not work for Social Services.

The focus of the counselling sessions will be to listen to your feelings surrounding the adoption, or possible adoption of your child or children. We are here to offer support to you at difficult times.

We aim for our service to be as flexible as possible in order that we can be sensitive and responsive to your individual needs.

Additionally your child's social worker may contact us to make us aware that you have a right to receive this free service. We would then contact you, answer any questions you may have and discuss if this is a service that you would be interested in. The choice is always yours.

Who will be told about what is discussed in the sessions?

No One!

Birth family counselling is confidential. The exception to this is if concerns arise about safety.
